

Pastor's Letter

Dear Friends,

Next week, I start a series of homilies on the Seven Deadly Sins. We will accompany Dante through Purgatory (of The Divine Comedy), not so much to know how we can get rid of the sin but how we can avoid it in the first place. If we do fall into one of the Deadly Sins, we have the lifeline, our way out the virtue, the antidote. Here is a helpful outline you can use... cut it out and refer to it.



Seven Deadly Sins

and Seven Lively Vintues

PRIDE HUMILITY REALITY

Understanding ourselves and our relationship to Almighty God and realizing that we depend on Him for every good thing. All that we have is from Him.

The proud are purged by carrying giant stones on their backs, unable to stand up straight, teaching them that pride puts weight on the soul, and it is better to throw it off. The prayer for this terrace is the Lord's Prayer, and the Beatitude is "Blessed are the poor in spirit."

> **ENVY KINDNESS ADMIRATION**

Habit of loving God for who He is and others for the sake of God. Our model is the Trinity: Father's love for the Son and Holy Spirit.

The envious are purged, having their eyes sewn shut since they have compared themselves with others and been found lacking.

ANGER (WRATH) PATIENCE FORGIVENESS

Moderating our anger and desire for revenge. Bearing wrongs with patience, humility and charity, trusting in God's providence.

The wrathful are purged by walking around in acrid smoke. Souls correct themselves by learning how wrath has blinded their vision, impeding their judgment. The prayer for this terrace is the Agnus Dei, and the Beatitude is "Blessed are the peacemakers."

> **SLOTH DILIGENCE** ZEAL

Doing God's work joyfully... zeal for the mission.

The slothful are purged by continually running, hearing "Mary proceeded in haste." Those who were slothful in life can only purge this sin by being zealous in their desire for penance. Spiritual laziness and lack of caring lead to sadness, and so the Beatitude for this terrace is "Blessed are they that mourn, for they shall be comforted."

GREED (AVARICE) CHARITY GENEROSITY

Sharing God's gifts to us with all His children.

The greedy are purged by lying face-down on the ground, unable to move. The one with excessive concern for earthly goods learns to turn his desire from possessions, power or position to God.

GLUTTONY TEMPERANCE SELF-DENIAL

Using all of God's worldly gifts in moderation.

The gluttonous are purged by abstaining from any food or drink. To sharpen the pains of hunger, the former gluttons on this terrace are forced to pass by cascades of cool water without stopping to drink, while saying, "Lord, open my lips..."

> **LUST CHASTITY** TRUE-LOVE

Obeying God's design for our sexuality. Using this gift only in marriage and as God intends: to increase a married couple's bond of love and to procreate children with God.

The lustful are purged by burning in an immense wall of flames. All of those who committed sexual sins are purified by the fire. Excessive sexual desire misdirects one's love from God and this terrace is meant to correct that.





FROM THE CATECHISM

Sin and Its Consequences

- CCC 1849 "Sin is an offense against reason, truth, and right conscience; it is failure in genuine love for God and neighbor caused by a perverse attachment to certain goods."
- CCC 1866 "Vices can be classified according to the virtues they oppose, or be linked to the capital sins... They are called 'capital' because they engender other sins, other vices.'
- CCC 1869 "Sins give rise to social situations and institutions that are contrary to the divine goodness."




