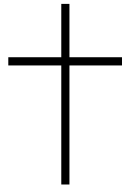


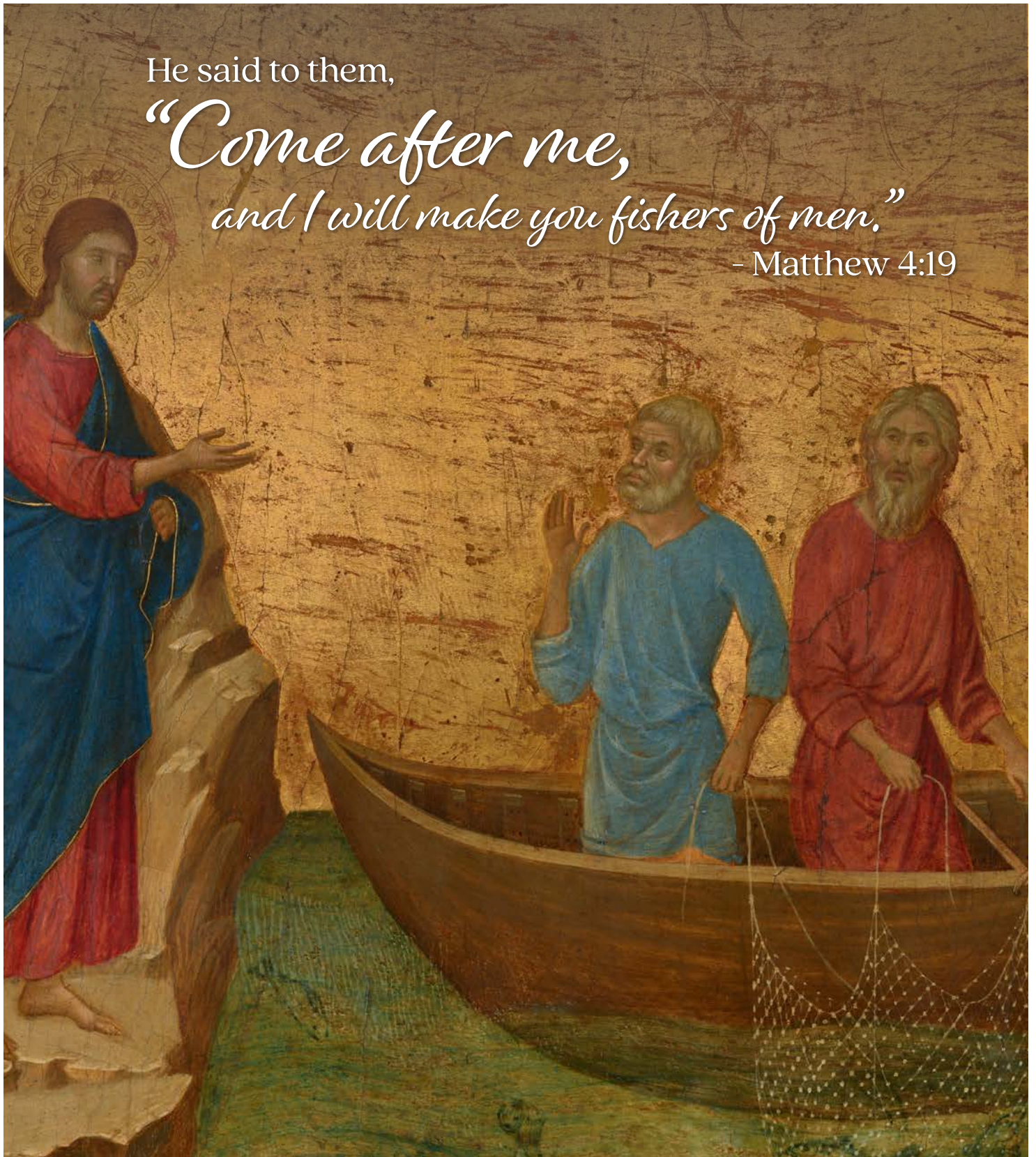

### CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK



**Catholic Schools**  
United in Faith and Community

Catholic education is a gift of light. In classrooms filled with prayer, learning, and love, children discover not only knowledge, but their identity as sons and daughters of God. During Catholic Schools Week, we give thanks for schools that form minds, shape hearts, and teach students to live as disciples of Jesus Christ. May we continue to support and strengthen Catholic education, so that the light of Christ may shine through every child, today and for generations to come.

### FROM THE CATECHISM

**CCC 2221** — “Education is the responsibility first of parents... Parents have a grave responsibility to give good example to their children.”

**CCC 820** — “Christ bestowed unity on His Church from the beginning. This unity, we believe, subsists in the Catholic Church as something she can never lose, and we hope that it will continue to increase until the end of time. Christ always gives His Church the gift of unity, but the Church must always pray and work to maintain, reinforce, and perfect the unity that Christ wills for her. This is why Jesus Himself prayed at the hour of His Passion, and never ceases to pray to His Father, for the unity of His disciples: “That they may all be one. As You, Father, are in Me and I in You, may they also be one in us, so that the world may believe that You have sent Me.”



When Jesus heard that John had been arrested, He withdrew to Galilee. He left Nazareth and went to live in Capernaum by the sea, in the region of Zebulun and Naphtali, that what had been said through Isaiah the prophet might be fulfilled:

*Land of Zebulun and land of Naphtali, the way to the sea, beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles, the people who sit in darkness have seen a great light, on those dwelling in a land overshadowed by death light has arisen.*

From that time on, Jesus began to preach and say, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.”

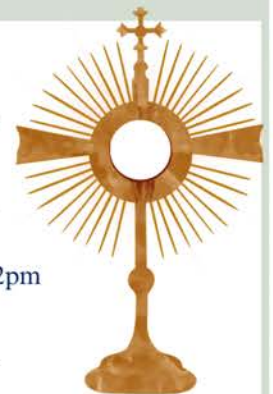
