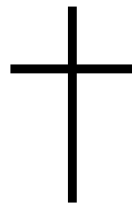

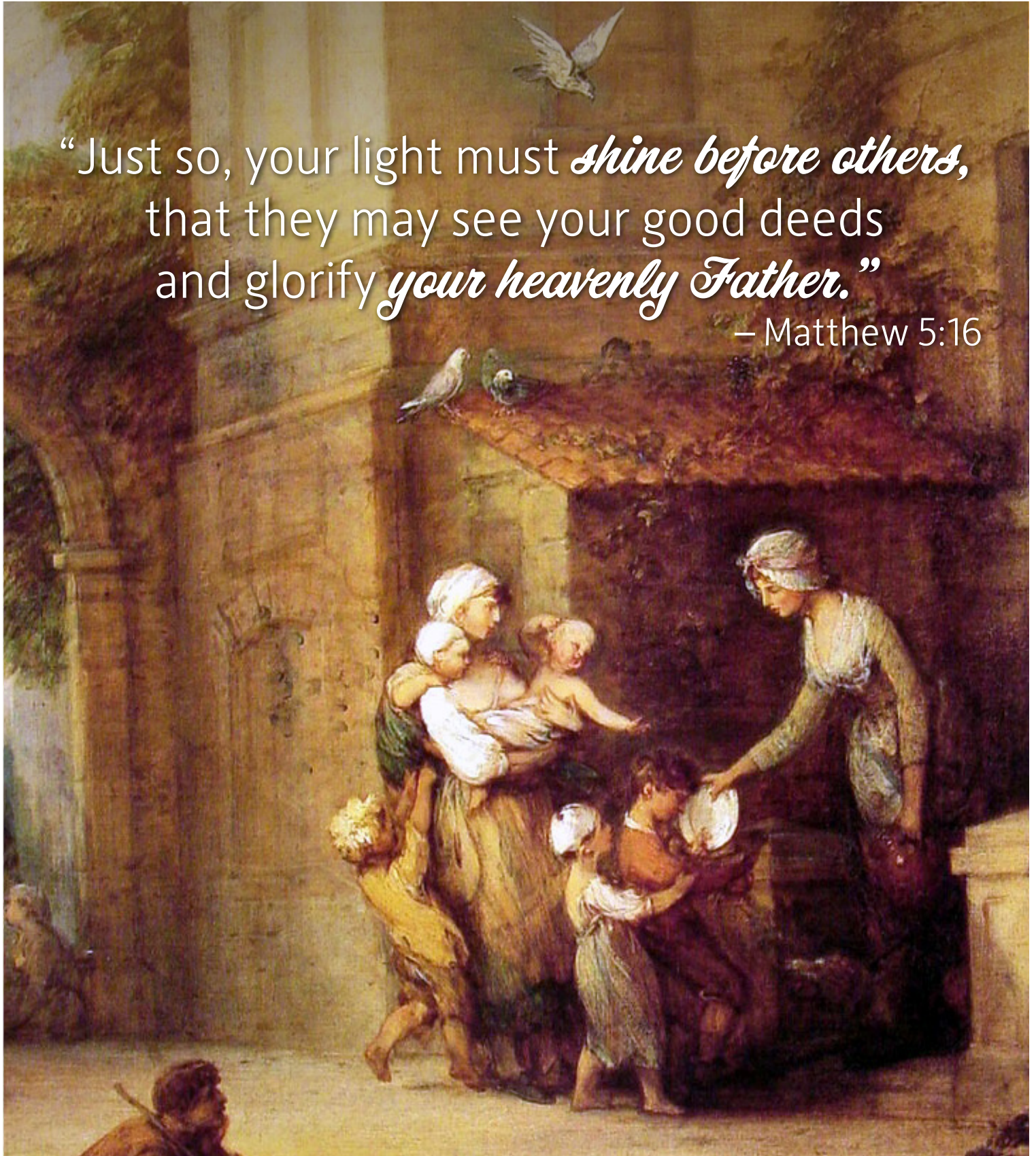

## You are the Salt of the Earth...

*You are the light of the world!*

Dear Friends:

Jesus says that to you—right here, right now, in Monroe. That matters, because many young adults are quietly asking the same questions:

Do I matter? Do I make a difference? Does my faith actually belong in my real life—my job, my friendships, my social media, my future? Jesus answers with two images: salt and light.

Salt and light have one thing in common: neither exists for itself. Salt gives itself away to preserve and enhance food. Light gives itself away so that everything else can be seen. Salt doesn't call attention to itself; it makes food taste more like what it already is. Light doesn't shout; it reveals.

That's how faith works in real life.

Salt does something surprising. The same salt makes fish taste fishier, eggs eggier, and duck and venison delicious. It brings out what's already there. Light does the same thing. It makes colors clearer, shapes sharper, reality more real.

God's grace works that way in you. Grace doesn't erase your personality, your talents, your questions, or your ambitions. It perfects them. Grace doesn't make you less human—it makes you more human. God is not threatened by your growth. He delights in it.

Look at Jesus. He is fully God and fully human. His divinity doesn't shrink His humanity; it completes it. In Him, we see who God is—and who we are meant to become.

That matters in a culture that constantly forces young adults into either/or choices:

Faith or freedom.  
 Truth or love.  
 Church or authenticity.

The Gospel offers something better: both/and. Faith and freedom. Truth and love. Conviction and compassion.

Jesus also says, "Let your light shine before others." That can feel uncomfortable. No one wants to be labeled "that religious person." But Jesus is not asking for performative holiness or online preaching. He warns against that elsewhere.

We are not meant to be stars. We are meant to be mirrors.

A mirror doesn't create light; it reflects it. When your life is turned toward God—through prayer, integrity, generosity, and mercy—His light shows up naturally. In how you work. How you date. How you forgive. How you stand for truth without cruelty.

Sometimes that will mean speaking up. Other times it will mean quiet fidelity when no one notices. Both matter.

In a city like Monroe, where everyone knows everyone, authenticity speaks louder than slogans. People may not always agree with your faith—but they will notice peace, purpose, and joy when they see it.

Jesus is telling you this:

You don't have to become someone else to follow Him.

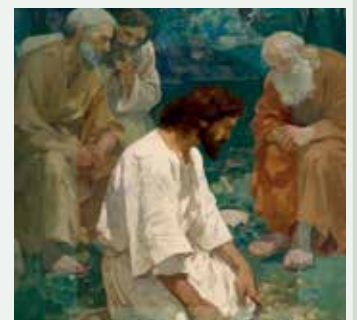
You don't have to be louder—just brighter.
