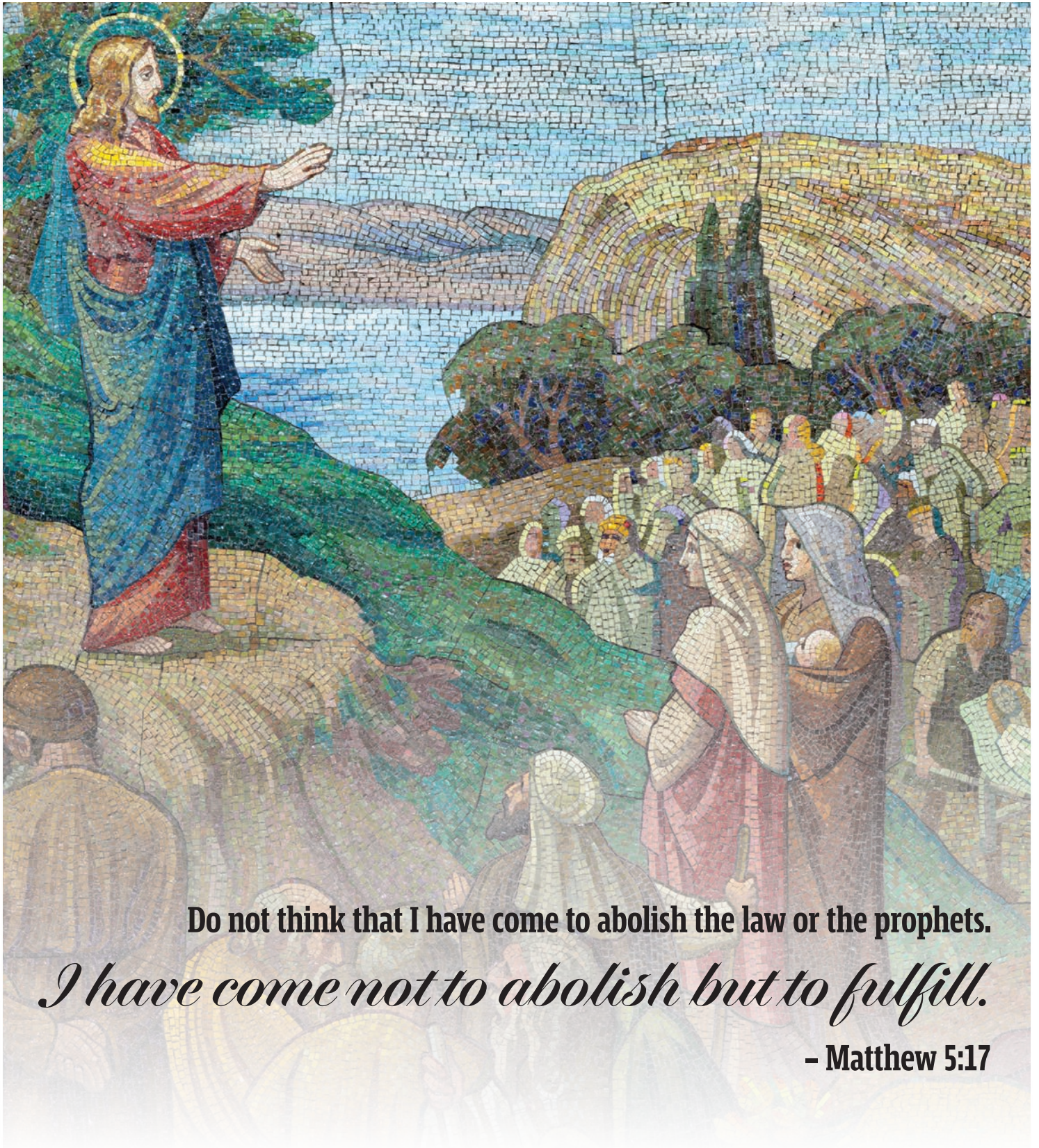

Living Lent on Purpose

A Season of Intention

Dear Friends:

Most of us could name the three pillars of Lent without much effort: prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. The challenge isn't knowing them; it's actually living them in a way that changes us.

Lent isn't meant to be a spiritual endurance test or a Catholic version of a self-improvement challenge. It's an invitation to conversion: to clear away what distracts us from God so we can better receive what He wants to give us. Easter joy is real, but it's not accidental. We prepare for it.

Here are a few practical ways to approach each pillar this Lent. Think of these less as a checklist and more as a menu. Start where you are, but don't be afraid to choose something that stretches you.

Prayer

Prayer doesn't always mean "doing more"; sometimes it means doing less so we can actually listen. Spend a few minutes each day in silence. No phone, no radio, no background noise. Just sit with the Lord, even if it feels awkward at first. Especially if it feels awkward.

Pray with Scripture slowly. Read the Gospel ahead of Mass or imagine yourself in the scene rather than rushing to the next page.

Be more intentional at Mass. Arrive a little early, stay a moment longer, and resist the urge to treat it like another item on the weekend schedule.

Fasting

Fasting isn't about willpower or earning holiness points. It's about creating space and remembering that we don't live on comfort alone. Fast from something that has a hold on your attention: constant noise, social media, streaming, or the need to always be "in the know." Practice restraint in everyday choices. Eat simply, pause before indulging, and let hunger or inconvenience turn your heart toward prayer. Fast from control. This one can be especially challenging. Intentionally step back. Let someone else choose, lead, or set the pace, and pay attention to what that reveals in your heart.

Almsgiving

Almsgiving is more than money; it's the gift of ourselves. Support parish ministries and local outreach efforts in a concrete way, whether through donations, time, or prayer. Be generous close to home. Give patience to a family member, attention to someone who feels unseen, or forgiveness where it's overdue. Look for opportunities to serve quietly, without recognition. God sees what no one else does.

This Lent, we are also offering a **parish Lenten Mission focused on the Eucharist**, the very heart of our Catholic faith. In a culture where belief in the Real Presence is often misunderstood or quietly set aside, this mission is an opportunity to step back, listen, and allow Christ to re-center our lives around Himself.

The mission is not "extra credit" for the especially holy. **It is a gift for anyone who wants help living Lent well.** If you have ever struggled with prayer, felt distracted at Mass, or sensed that your faith has become routine, **this mission is for you.** Making time for it is itself an act of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving: prayer through reflection and worship, fasting through setting aside other commitments, and almsgiving through the gift of your time and attention. Lent doesn't ask us to do everything. It asks us to do something, and to do it intentionally. I strongly encourage you to make the Lenten Mission part of your plan this season. Choose at least one practice that will truly stretch you, trust that God will meet you there, and allow this Lent to prepare you not just to celebrate Easter, *but to be changed by it.*
