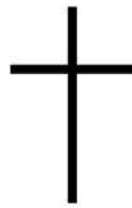

Temptations

Dear Friends:

Why does Lent begin with Jesus being tempted in the desert? That's not random—and it matters for you, right here at JGS.

This story is something only Jesus Himself could have told. No one else was there. He was alone. That means Lent begins not with theories or rules, but with Jesus opening His heart and saying, "This is what temptation really looks like."

Jesus was fully human. That means He felt hunger, pressure, loneliness, and stress—just like you do. Being tempted is not a sin. Giving in is. Adam and Eve gave in. Jesus did not. Lent is about learning how to stand where He stood.

The devil uses three strategies. You'll recognize all of them.

First, comfort. Jesus is starving, and the devil says, "Turn stones into bread." In other words: take care of yourself first. Forget what you promised God. That temptation shows up every day—in skipping prayer, cheating, lying, or saying, "I'll worry about God later." Lent trains us to say, "God comes first—even when it's uncomfortable."

Second, attention. "Throw yourself down," the devil says. "Everyone will believe if you do something dramatic." Jesus refuses. He doesn't chase followers, likes, or popularity. Here in Monroe, where everyone knows everyone, that pressure is real. Faith lived quietly, consistently, and honestly is harder—but it's real. God doesn't want performers. He wants faithful sons and daughters.

Third comes the hardest temptation: compromise. The devil offers Jesus success—saving everyone—if He will just bend the rules once. "Just one exception. Just one sin. Think of the good outcome." That logic hasn't changed. "Everyone else does it." "It's not that bad." "At least my intentions are good." Lent teaches us that God's commandments are not negotiable—and that love never comes from betrayal.

This is why Lent matters for you at JGS.

Lent is training—not punishment. Prayer trains your heart to listen. Fasting trains your will to say no. Almsgiving trains your eyes to see others.

When you come forward for Holy Communion at this altar, you're making a choice. You're saying: "Jesus, You come first. Not my comfort. Not my image. Not my popularity."

Lent is not about being miserable. It's about becoming strong.

Strong enough to stand for what's right at school. Strong enough to say no when others say yes. Strong enough to choose Christ—every single day. That's how young saints are made. And that's how God changes the world—starting right here.

FROM THE CATECHISM

CCC 397 — “Man, tempted by the devil, let his trust in his Creator die in his heart and, abusing his freedom, disobeyed God’s command. This is what man’s first sin consisted of. All subsequent sin would be disobedience toward God and lack of trust in his goodness.”

CCC 1430 — “Jesus’ call to conversion and penance does not aim first at outward works, but at the conversion of the heart, interior conversion. Without this, such penances remain sterile and false; however, interior conversion urges expression in visible signs, gestures and works of penance.”
