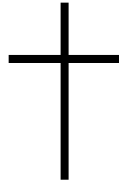

Every Journey Needs a Vehicle

Take the next step!

Dear Friends:

Sometimes the Sunday readings at Mass feel disconnected. Today, they aren't. In fact, today's Scriptures give us the whole meaning of life—in four clear steps. And for young adults trying to figure out direction, purpose, and faith in a noisy world, that matters.

The journey begins with Abraham. His story is simple and terrifying: God says, "Go," and Abraham goes. He leaves what's familiar, comfortable, and predictable. Every life is a journey, and every journey begins with God. None of us created ourselves. And none of us end with ourselves either. Whether you know it yet or not, your life begins in God and is meant to end in God.

Every journey needs a vehicle. The vehicle is faith.

Faith is not something you inherit like eye color. It's not something your parents can hand you. It's a personal decision. Abraham could have said no. You can too. Faith is not just believing ideas—it's trusting a Person. It's saying, "God, I don't see the whole map, but I trust You enough to take the next step."

The Psalm today gives us the road map by showing us who God actually is. Not who social media says He is. Not who bad experiences say He is. Scripture says God is upright, trustworthy, just, kind, and near. He knows you. He helps you. He protects you. Imagine trying to build a life if even one of those things were not true. Faith would collapse. But God has revealed Himself—and He does not lie.

Then St. Paul tells us the direction of the journey: holiness. That word scares people. It shouldn't. Holiness doesn't mean being weird or miserable. Saints are the happiest people who have ever lived. Holiness is becoming fully alive, fully yourself, fully free. If heaven doesn't interest you, holiness won't either—because holiness is simply learning how to live heaven now.

Finally, the Gospel shows us the destination. Jesus is transfigured. The apostles catch a glimpse of glory. This is what awaits us: not clouds and harps, but joy so real it overwhelms every cynicism we've ever had. Heaven is not boring. It's the fulfillment of everything we've ever wanted but couldn't name.

So faith is the vehicle.
 God's Word is the map.
 Holiness is the direction.
 And joy—real joy—is the destination.

That's why Lent exists. Not to make you miserable, but to make you free. We give up what makes us smaller—selfishness, fear, pride—so we can receive what makes us larger: trust, love, and hope.

Being a Christian is not playing it safe.

It's the greatest adventure there is.

And God is inviting you—right here at JGS, right now in your life—to take the next step.

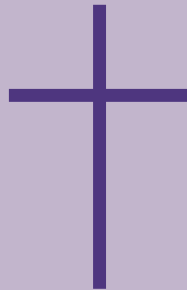
