Lent with Mary

Four Popes, One Path

Dear Friends:

Last week, I wrote about our journey of Lent with the help of the early Church Fathers. Today, let's look to the recent popes for guidance on this journey.

Every Lent, the Church invites us to walk a familiar road — prayer, fasting, almsgiving, conversion. But she also gives us a companion for the journey: the Blessed Virgin Mary. What is striking is that the last four popes — Pope St. John Paul II, Pope Benedict XVI, Pope Francis, and Pope Leo XIV — all return to Mary again and again when they speak about Lent. Different voices, different styles, but one clear message: **We do not walk this season alone.**

Pope St. John Paul II spoke of Lent as a time of decision. He asked whether we would arrive at Easter with hearts full of ourselves and hands empty for others — or, guided by Mary, with hearts made poor enough to receive God and hands full of gifts to share. For him, Mary was not just a comfort; she was a challenge. She teaches us how to fight the spiritual battle of Lent, how to resist sin, and how to keep God at the center of our lives. When we turn to her, he said, she makes us aware of the powerful presence of her Son, the true Conqueror.

Pope Benedict XVI continued this teaching, but with his own quiet depth. He described Lent as a renewed experience of God's love — a love revealed on the Cross and meant to be given away again, especially to those who suffer. He called Mary the "Mother of Beautiful Love" and asked her to guide us through a Lent of real conversion. For Benedict, Mary teaches us how to love not just with feelings, but with sacrifice — how to stand at the Cross and remain faithful when love becomes costly.

Pope Francis often spoke of Mary as a mother who walks patiently with her children. He would remind us that she never tires of bringing us back to God, especially when our hearts are tangled by fear, disappointment, or sin. At the foot of the Cross, Francis said, Mary teaches us how to stand and how to stay. That is a very Lenten lesson. **Faith is not always clarity; sometimes it is simply remaining when everything else feels uncertain.**

And Pope Leo XIV has taken up this same thread in our own day, pointing again to Mary's "yes" — not as a single moment in the past, but as a daily choice. He reminds us that Lent is the season when we renew that "yes" again and again. Mary shows us how to welcome God's will each day, even when we do not see where it will lead. She clears the way for Christ, never replacing Him, always pointing to Him.

Four popes. One path. One mother.

So this Lent, let us walk with Mary deliberately. Let us ask her to help us fight, love, stay, and say "yes" again. If we do, Easter will not simply arrive on the calendar — it will arrive in our hearts.


