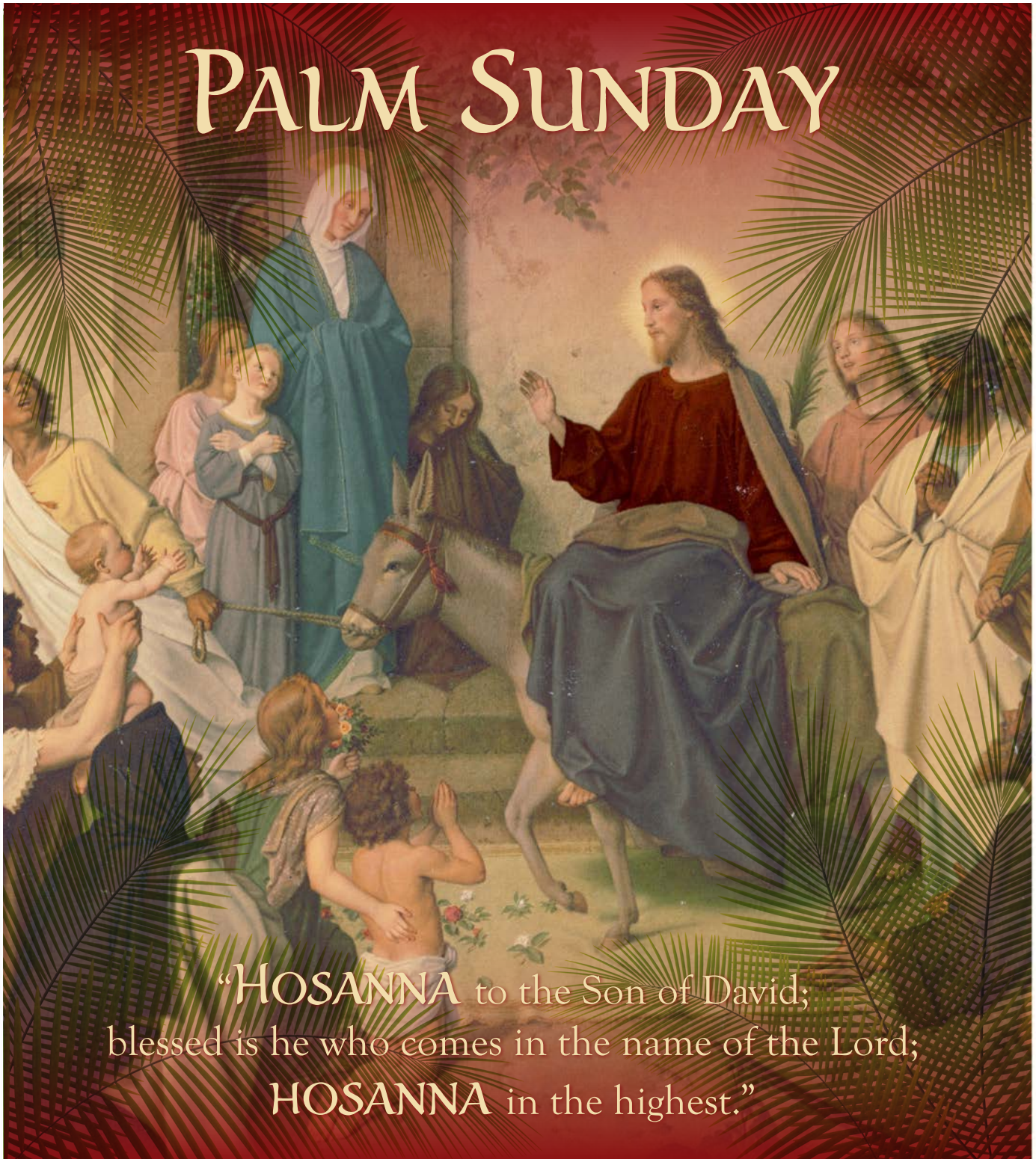

## Mary in the Shadows of Holy Week

Dear Friends:

Holy Week does not belong to the crowds.

It belongs to the faithful.

The crowds shout on Palm Sunday. They wave branches. They sing. They cheer. But Mary is not among the shouters. She is among the watchers. She knows (perhaps more than anyone) how quickly voices change, how quickly palms become fists, how quickly praise becomes silence.

She watches her Son enter Jerusalem, not as a king with armies, but as a king riding a borrowed donkey. She remembers another day when she carried Him in her arms into another holy city, when Simeon's words pierced her heart like a blade: "And you yourself a sword shall pierce." Holy Week is the moment that sword begins to turn.

As Jesus goes to the Upper Room on Holy Thursday, Mary is not there, but her heart is. She knows that the One she once fed at her breast is now feeding the world with His own Body and Blood. She knows what bread and sacrifice cost. She has lived it for thirty-three years.

While the apostles sleep, while Judas slips into the night, while the world turns quietly against Him, Mary keeps vigil. A mother always knows when her child is in danger.

And then comes Good Friday.

The Church tells us simply: "Standing by the Cross of Jesus was His mother."

Standing. Not collapsing. Not screaming. Standing.

She stands as the earth trembles.

She stands as the sky darkens.

She stands as the heart of God breaks open for the world.

Every parent in Ouachita Parish understands this moment. The helplessness. The ache. The terrible courage it takes to remain present when you cannot fix what is happening to someone you love. Mary does not flee. She does not look away. She gives Jesus what she has always given Him: her presence, her faith, her yes.

And in that moment, from the Cross, Jesus gives her to us. "Behold your mother."

Holy Week is not just the story of Jesus' suffering. It is the story of a mother who loves to the end — and who teaches us how to love when loving hurts.

So this week, I invite you to walk Holy Week with Mary.

Hold your palm branch with reverence. Sit in silence on Holy Thursday. Come to the Cross on Good Friday and stand with her.

**Do not rush past these days.**

**Do not soften them.**

Let them change you.

Because Mary teaches us that the way to Easter always passes through love that is willing to stay, even in the dark.

And she is still standing there, waiting for us.

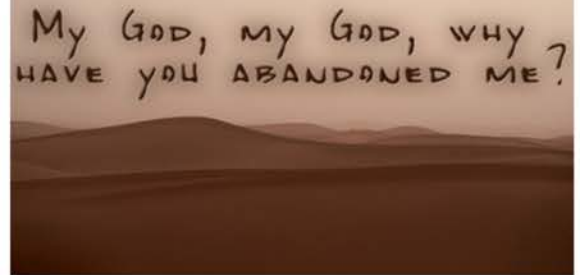
