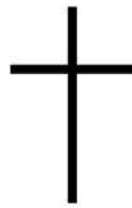

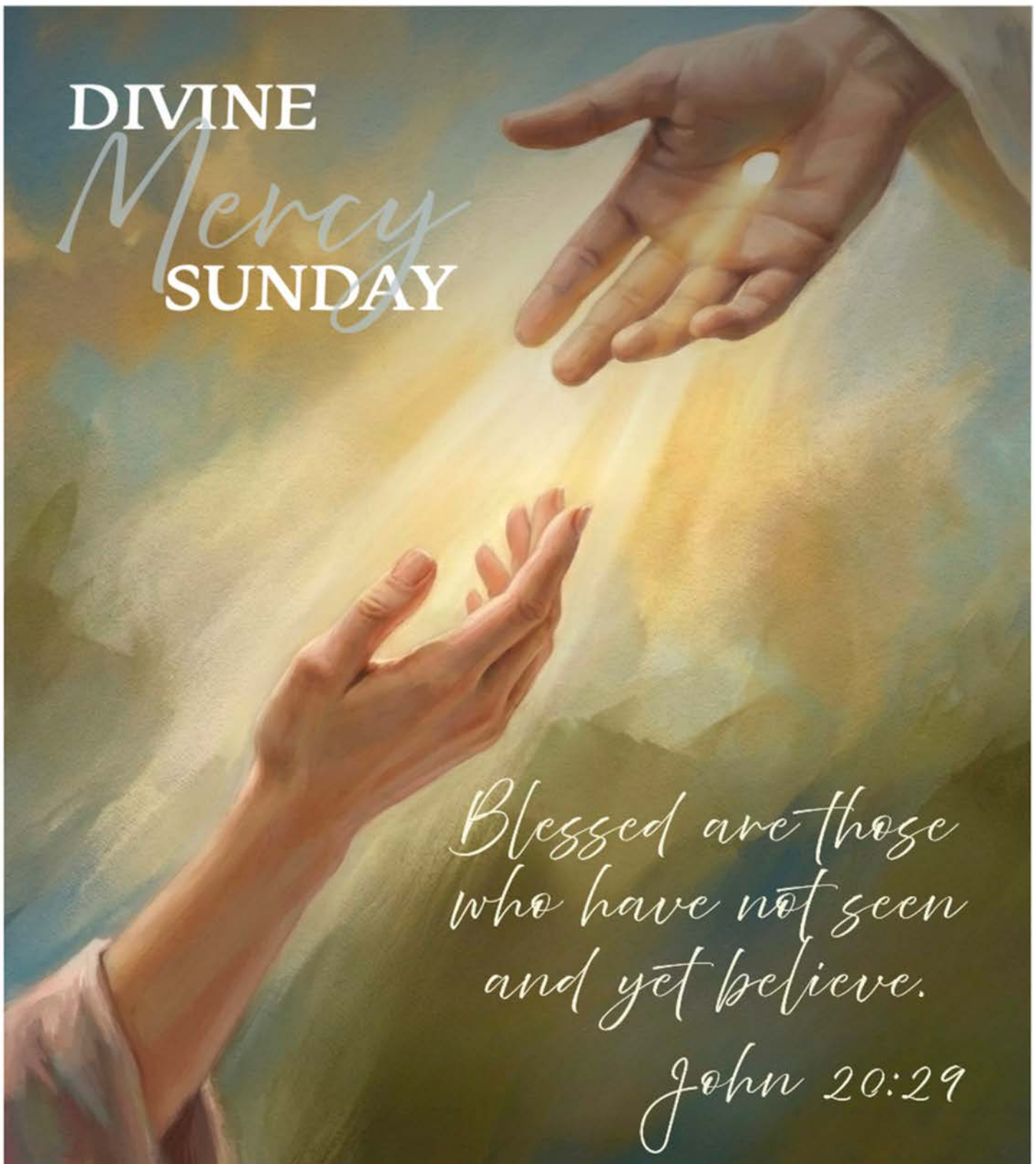

## From Doubt to Faith

## Trusting Jesus

Dear Friends:

Thomas is often noted as “Doubting Thomas” because he proclaimed that he wouldn’t believe that Jesus rose from the dead unless he saw with his own eyes and touched the wounds of the crucified Jesus. Thomas, one of the “Twelve,” was with Jesus for three years before the crucifixion. He had front row seats to the teachings and acts of Jesus. He witnessed many miracles, saw dignity restored, lives uplifted. There is no question that Thomas believed in Jesus. But like the other Apostles, his faith was put to the test at the death of Jesus on the Cross. The one they believed in was “gone.” Even though Jesus had promised His Resurrection, death seemed to be the end of what they believed. Since Thomas was not present for the first appearance of the Resurrected Jesus in the Upper Room, he could not bring himself to believe in the testimony of his brothers who were. He had to “see it” for himself. Jesus came to him in his doubt, in his fear, and invited Thomas to touch His wounds – leading him to proclaim one of the most profound statements of faith in Scripture: “My Lord and my God.”

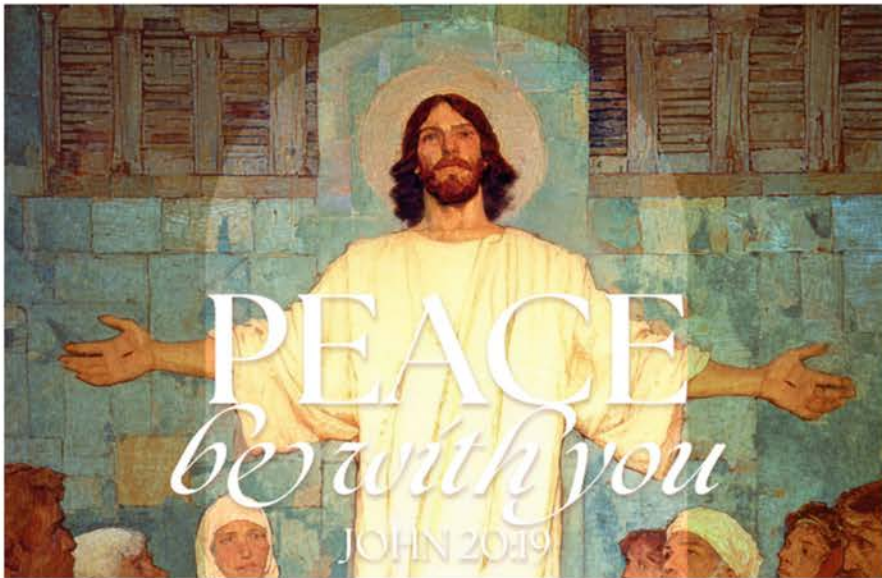
Faith without seeing is a blessing, Jesus pronounces in front of the Apostles in the Upper Room after Thomas sees the Resurrected Jesus. Though not impossible, instantaneous “blind” faith is rare. For most of us, that level of faith is a journey of awakenings to truth over time, often tested with real life events, just like Thomas. Faith can be passed down through generations by instruction and example. Sometimes, we are moved after a personal experience or encounter with profound love. Many have a “belief in” Jesus. God is calling us to more than believing in – for even Satan believes in Jesus. Faith is a gift from God, an opening of our heart where we experience Him, encounter Him, and trust Him. Like any gift, it can be put aside.

Real, enduring faith requires **opening** the gift: **allowing** His revelation to transform us, **submitting** to His will, **trusting** in His relationship of love and mercy with us, and then **living out** that faith in love of others through love of Him. Through faith, we receive grace to endure all trials and even be transformed by them. “*Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed.*”

**CCC 150** — “Faith is first of all a personal adherence of man to God; it is a gift that must be received, opened, and lived, transforming the heart to trust in divine mercy and to respond in love through action.”

**CCC 161** — “Believing in Jesus Christ and in the One who sent Him for our salvation is necessary for obtaining that salvation; even when faith is tested by doubt, suffering, or the silence of God, the believer is called to trust in the truth revealed and to persevere in hope.”

**CCC 164** — “Faith is often lived in darkness, sustained not by sight but by trust in God’s promises; through trials that test its authenticity, faith grows stronger and leads the believer to a deeper encounter with Christ.”

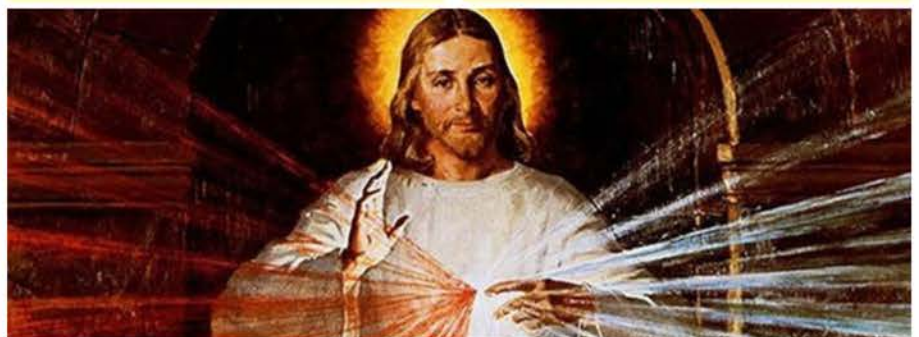

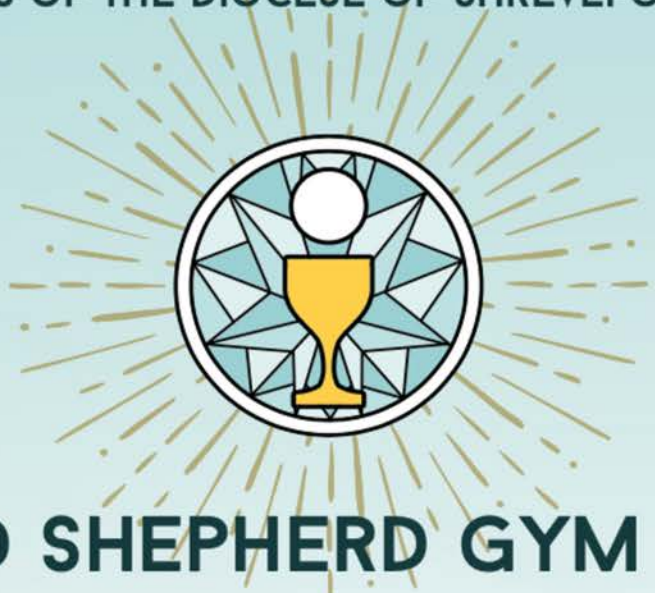
