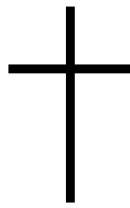

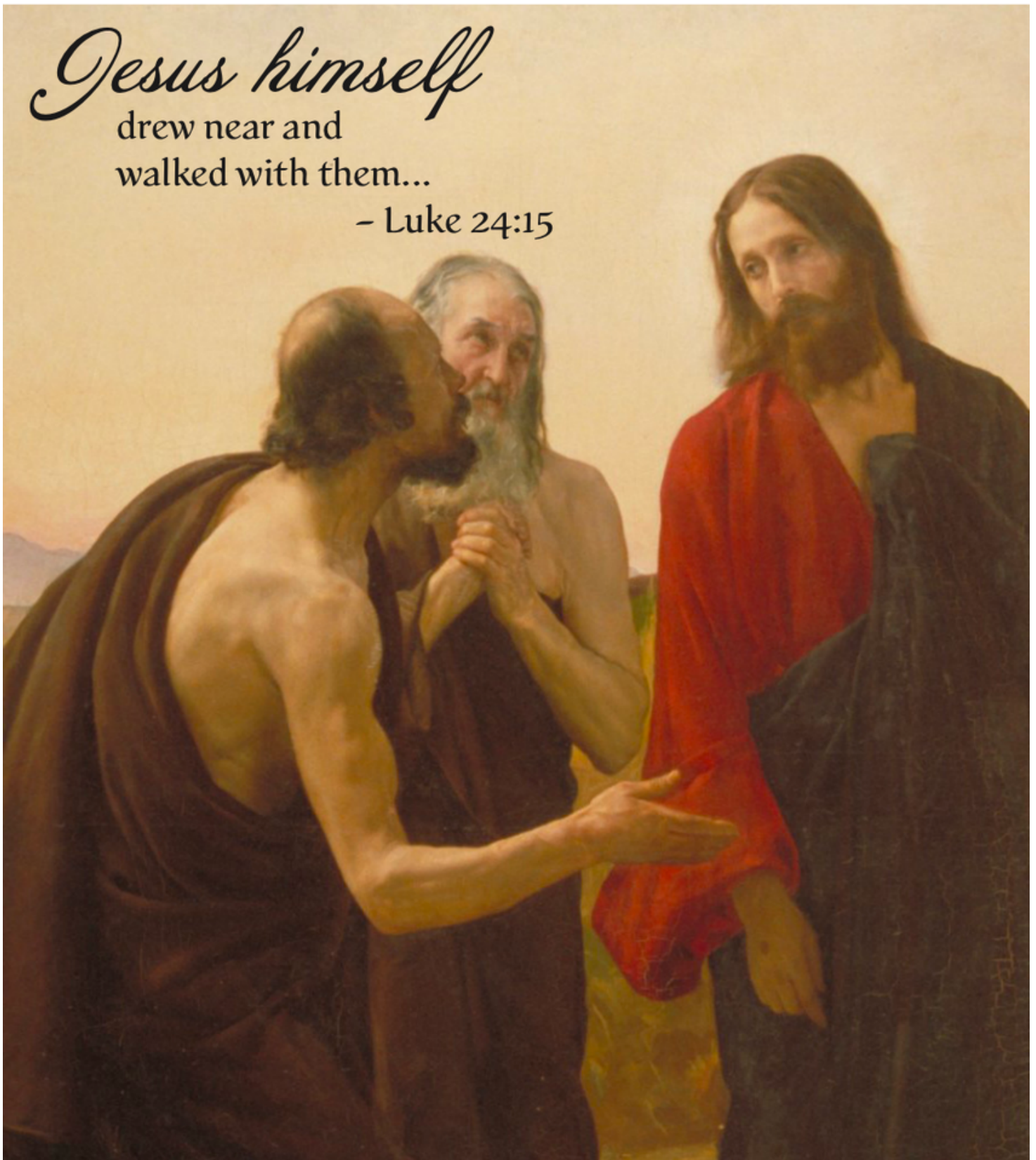

Welcome

A Burning Heart

Right Here at Home

Dear Friends:

On the Third Sunday of Easter each year, the Church gives us one of the most beloved Gospel stories in all of Scripture—the journey to Emmaus. Two disciples walk along the road, confused, disappointed, and discouraged. They had hoped. They had believed. But now everything seemed lost.

And then Jesus drew near and walked with them.

They did not recognize Him at first. That is important. Because it reminds us that the Lord often walks beside us in ways we do not immediately see. He walks with us in our grief, in our questions, in our routines, and even in our doubts.

What changed everything for those two disciples was not simply new information. It was an encounter. As Jesus opened the Scriptures to them, their hearts began to burn. Later they would say to one another, *“Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the Scriptures to us?”* That phrase—burning hearts—captures the essence of the Christian life.

Faith is not merely knowing facts about God. Faith is a living relationship with Him. Theology is not just theory; it is meant to change our lives. The truths we believe are not distant ideas. They are realities that give us hope, strength, and direction. They are like a map for the journey of life.

And hope is grounded in something solid. The Resurrection of Jesus is not a symbol or a wish. It is an event that really happened in history. Because Christ truly rose from the dead, our future is secure. As the Letter to the Hebrews reminds us, *“Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.”* He is Lord of the past, Lord of the present, and Lord of the future.

But the Emmaus story does not end on the road. The decisive moment comes at the table.

The Gospel tells us that the disciples finally recognized Jesus *“in the breaking of the bread.”* That is not accidental language. It is the language of the Eucharist. They came to know Him when He took bread, blessed it, broke it, and gave it to them. The same thing happens at every Mass.

And it happens **right here**—at **Jesus the Good Shepherd in Monroe**.

Every weekend, families walk through our doors carrying the same things those disciples carried: worries about children and grandchildren, concerns about health, questions about the future, gratitude for blessings, and sometimes quiet burdens that no one else sees. And every time we gather at this altar, the risen Lord draws near and walks with us. He opens His Word to us. He feeds us with His very life.

We are not just a parish that gathers.
We are a people on the road together.
And Christ is in our midst.

The invitation of this Gospel is simple and very personal: Ask the Lord to set your heart on fire again. Come to Mass with expectation. Listen to His Word with attention. Receive Him in Holy Communion with faith. And then leave this place ready to carry that fire into your home, your workplace, your school, and every corner of our community here in Monroe.

Because when Christ is present,
hearts burn, hope returns,
and lives are changed.

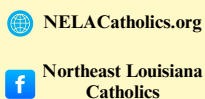

Public Notice – Action Required

Sexual Abuse Claims in the Diocese of Alexandria Bankruptcy

Regardless of how old you are today or when the sexual abuse occurred,
you need to file your claim so that it is received by June 8, 2026.

The Diocese of Alexandria (“Diocese” or “Debtor”) has filed bankruptcy to restructure its nonprofit organization and pay Putative Abuse Survivors. Please read this notice carefully as it may impact your rights against the Diocese and provides information about the case, *In re: Diocese of Alexandria*, Case No. 25-31257 (Bankr. W.D. La.). This notice is a short summary. For more detail, go to <https://cases.stretto.com/dioceceofalexandria> or call (855) 655-5795.

Who Should File a Putative Abuse Survivor Claim?

Anyone who alleges they were abused and believes the Diocese, or persons affiliated with the Diocese, may be responsible for the abuse must file a claim. This includes abuse in connection with any entity or activity associated with the Diocese, including schools, orphanages, parishes, or Catholic Charities. A list of such entities associated with the Diocese is available on the website or by calling the toll-free number listed below. If you have an abuse claim against any entity on that list, you may have a claim against the Diocese. Only the Diocese is in bankruptcy. If you have a claim against any entity on that list, you must take additional legal action to preserve and pursue your rights.

When and How Should I File a Putative Abuse Survivor Claim?

You should file a claim using the Putative Abuse Survivor Proof of Claim so that it is received by June 8, 2026. If you do not file a timely Putative Abuse Survivor Claim, you may lose rights against the Diocese, including any right to compensation.

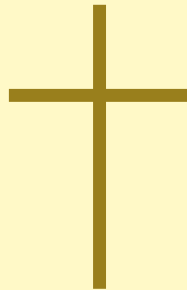
